Review Strategic Plan/ Action Plan	Reviewed and updated. Doing better in some areas compared to others. COVID has made some of our goals difficult to meet. Goal for 2021—Designate certain months for engagement/targeting (school nurses, certain businesses, etc.)	

<p>Partner Sharing</p>	<p>Meeker Memorial—no update available</p> <p>GRH—email update: Breastfeeding class went virtual. 2 participants, awaiting their survey responses. Deciding on hosting virtual or in person for January class.</p> <p>Hutch Health—Prenatal classes are online. Unsure about breastfeeding class but most likely using same online model. Continuing in-person outpatient lactation visits 2-3 days/week. Have had 1 COVID+ mom (able to do phone visits until 14-day window passed)</p> <p>Public Health—Staffing changes for Meeker and McLeod counties. All visits continue to be virtual with the exception of an infant weight check as needed.</p> <p>Moms Like You/BF Peers—Tried an in-person MLY meeting at a park but rescheduled. Continuing 2 virtual meetings/month with good attendance. Will most likely plan to keep at least one meeting virtual even after COVID restrictions are lifted. Hiring a peer—many applicants! Increasing involvement and outreach.</p> <p>WIC—Phone appointments until at least February. Info released at WIC BF Coordinator meeting showed rates down statewide. Lindsay is working on compiling breastfeeding rates for our counties and will share when completed.</p> <p>NFP—New WFH policy. Referrals are low but picking up; attributed to not having in-person WIC. Dixie has been doing outreach at the Food Share.</p> <p>Big Latch On—Facebook insights report 11.8k reach with 121 responses (71 “interested” and 51 “going”). 15 content posts and 5 community conversation/game posts. 19 giveaways. Official report: 19 nursers, 4 pumping, 2 supporters, 24 “latches”</p> <p>Others</p>	<p>Donate \$50 back to the Global Big Latch On from local BLO funds to support the mission.</p>
