2020 was a very different sort of year for everyone, to say the least. With COVID coming to the US in January, closures in March, and shifting priorities at our homes and workplaces, the Crow River Area Breastfeeding Coalition needed to get creative to remain resourceful and resilient.

Our usual meetings held in person at our three hospitals, were now held online via Zoom.

Our usual annual event, "The Big Latch-On" was also held virtually.

The Mom's Like You, breastfeeding support group organized by our WIC Peers, was also now a virtual event growing to twice monthly.

Although these may sound like daunting challenges, there was a bit of a

silver lining in each. Attendance increased at our monthly meetings with the ease of attending without the commute. The Big Latch On attendees expressed amazement and increased feeling of local support with the heartfelt stories shared online rather than just smiling a greeting at an event in the park. And the breastfeeding support group held virtually was easy for moms to pop on without leaving home, so much so that they are talking of increasing the number of meetings offered each month.

There have been challenges, no doubt, but we are getting through it together and we will be stronger for it in the end.
