Received \$200 Blue Plus and \$200 Prime West donation for BF event. \$80 was deposited from the Silent Auction. Expenses were \$581 for the event. Meg approved minutes, Lindsay second Lacey updated the BF resource guide in May 2024
Old Business	 WBW August recap- Lindsay Please see attached breastfeeding summary Coffective and BF/Equity Grant- Meg Coeffective: We received a \$5000 coeffective grant to provide CLC courses to local nurses through hospital partners. We were able to send 6 nurses through the training and provide all of the reading materials for them as well. With the final pieces of the funds we purchased Pump parts available to the public at the WIC offices. Equity in Lactation: We received \$5000 to provide baby baskets to folks who work with Peer courselors. These baskets retail for about \$80 per basket and we were able to purchase 55 baskets in total. The items in the baskets included Lanolin, reusable breast pads, a swaddle/cover, a woven diaper basket, breastfeeding affirmation cards that we custom made, hydrogel pads, milk storage bags, among other items donated by partners to add to the baskets. This has given us an opportunity to meet clients face to face and entice them to meet with us to get the baskets. The remaining funds were utilized for the World Breastfeeding Week Celebration

They have a CLC/CLS on staff during clinic hours that can help with breastfeeding support and address concerns immediately (weight, flange fitting, latching, etc).
